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EDITORIAL EDITORIAL





The Epistle of Precepts
(based on Shatanand's Shikshapatri
Arthadipika)
By Pravin S. Varsani

Text-72

On hearing the news of the arrival of the *Acharya*, my disciples shall go forthwith to the outskirts of the village or town to welcome him with honour and respect, and on his departure shall accompany him up to the outskirts of the village or town to bid him farewell.

Shatanand explains – Adara Vaditradisahitmityarthaha – one should immediately go and welcome the Acharya with the sound of musical instruments. This is in accordance with the teachings of Parashar.

Also one should offer gifts to the *Acharya* on his arrival. Those that accord such a welcome receive the fruits of a pilgrimage. Those that go to bid him farewell are freed from sin.

Text-73

One shall never undertake any activities that are devoid of Dharma, irrespective of its benefits, as Dharma alone can fulfill all human efforts; therefore one shall not give up Dharma in the hope of some benefits.

One shall always stay faithful to Dharma, as Dharma is the deliverer of all required wealth and happiness. There is nothing unachievable if one is faithful to Dharma. Therefore one should never act unrightheously, contrary to *Dharmic* law

even if such act will derive great benefits and prosperity. One should always stay true to Dharma. Even in unfavourable 'imes, one should never renounce their Dharma.

This again is as per the teachings of Parashar. *Dharma* as detailed in this Shikshapatri and other *Dharma Shastras* and is the only worthy science of behaviour. It is the only source of a fruitful life. Smruti explains: 'Dharma is the only deliverer of basic or worldly (Aihik) and greater (Parlaukik) happiness.' Consequently, **Dharmabhrashto Vinashyati** – 'Those that live contrary to Dharma face destruction.'

Text-74

One shall never adopt any of the unethical deed of the great people of the past but shall follow their ethical deeds only.

In the past, those who have performed great penances, who are learned in Yoga, who are famed for their divine nature, who are considered the best amongst mankind, but who have used somewhat unethical deeds, should not be imitated. Only the ethical deeds should be adopted.

These actions of such people were for a purpose. Just because they acted unethically does not give us the right to also act in such way. 'Undesirable acts should be renounced from even the mind. Those who foolishly commit such acts face destruction. Just as an ordinary man would surely face destruction if he was to try to imitate the act of Lord Shiva drinking poison from the river.'

A question here arises : Smruti explains : Shrotaha Smartastaha Shishtacharaprapto Vrusho Hitaha -

'Dharma arising from Shruti, Smruti and actions (of men) will always benefit mankind.' If the actions of the great men are the root of Dharma, then why is it that we should reject the unrighteous acts of the saints of the past?' the answer to this is simply that the Vedas, which are beyond Loka-Vyavahar (business and social thoughts), explain that unrighteous acts are the means of attaining knowledge.

Therefore the incidents of the past are there to be learnt from and not imitated. Specifically we can learn of the consequences that brew from the performance of such unrighteous act.

Shishtachara or righteous acts are detailed in Matsya Purana:

Daanam Satyam Tapoalobho Vidhyeja Poojanam Damaha | Ashto Tani Charitrani Shishtachasya Lakshanam ||

'Charity, truth, penance, unselfishness, knowledge, sacrifice (Yagna), worship and control of the senses are the eight attributes of Shishtachara.' Furthermore, the acts of Manu, Saptarshi and other great people of the past, in accordance with Dharma are considered as Shishtacharas. Only these Shistacharas are worthy of imitation. Shrimad Bhagwat explains, 'The unrighteous acts of ShishtaJans are contemptible and so should not be imitated by illustrious men. These acts were performed for the good of Mankind.'

Those acts pertaining to *Dharma*, penance, *Yoga*, truth, compassion etc. should be accepted as Sadachar. Only such acts will teach us the desired lessons for life. In *Moksha Dharma*, *Bhishma* says, *'The actions by Devtas (Gods) and Rishis that are contemptible should not be*

followed. Nor should such acts be slandered. Those who always think wisely about an act before hand always face prosperity.'

Many stories in *Puranas* exist which question one's faith. Acts of *Devas* and *Rishis* committing *Adharmic* unethical acts such as breaking the rule of Ahimsa or acts of lust sometimes make you think and question the. However, these affects are for the benefit of mankind, as this is revealed often after the episode. They help us to understand more closely the consequences of some of the sins committed. Sometimes the reasons for such act may not be clear and so in such situation one should never question the integrity of such acts.

One should never use these episodes as an excuse to act their *Adharmic* fantasies also. In the *Ramayan*, Indra enjoyed sexual bliss with *Gautama Patni – Ahaliya*. This episode should never be used for personal satisfaction to somehow support a claim that adultery is acceptable. Both *Indra* and *Ahaliya* paid a great price for their lapse – being cursed! This is the lesson to be learnt from this episode – that adulterous behavior will always lead to downfall and shame. These episodes are their to teach us a deeper meaning which sadly we all too often choose to ignore and take the episode at face value.

Similarly to say 'Mahadeva ate tobacco and so why can't we?' is ludicrous. Mahadeva also drank poison –Why don't you try drinking that?

Another great saying is from those who wish to indulge in mixed *Raasa-Dandia* – 'Krishna played *Raasa* with the *Gops* – so why shouldn't we?' this again is

unacceptable. Krishna is God Supreme and the *Gopis* were *Bhaktas*. The *Raasa* played was not between mere man and woman, but *Raasa* was played between *Bhakta* and *Bhagwan*. Indeed Krishna told the *Gopis* of their unfaithfulness to their husbands first and foremost, when the *Gopis* came late that night- abandoning their husband and children. It was only their intense love and devotion for Krishna who was clearly God, that brought about the inevitable *Raasa Leela*.

The Raasa was strictly between the Gopis and Krishna – the other Govarias played no part and therefore to reduce the Divya Raasa Lila to some lustful enactment is imply slanderous.

Raasa should always be played with such Bhavya, which is to please God. It should never be played for some lustful personal agenda. Raasa is indeed a form of Bhakti—devotion to God. It is played whilst Pradikshana (circumambulation) is performed and the divine pastimes of God are sung and remembered.

It seems that the Raasa-Garbas of the today has o such 'Bhava'. For a start they play in the opposite direction to Pradikshana where God (who is in the centre) is always to your right. Some Raasa-Garbas are played to popular Indian film songs and not to Kirtans. There is often a 'Disco' feel to the music. All in all many of the Youngsters do not go to the Raasa-Garbas for the religious aspect but for the social aspect.

If one can honestly say that he is undisturbed by the presence of a person of the opposite sex then I surrender my argument but I'm sure that all are affected by their presence. During *Raasa* one's senses should be under strict control and

this simply cannot be secured with the presence of the opposite sex – the mind will always wander.

Raja Parikshit, listening to the amorous acts of Shree Krishna in Rasa-Panchadyaya said in bewilderment, 'Krishna, the Lord of Yadus, is a spiritually awakened person without any unfulfilled desires in him. How did he then indulge in this most heinous sin of indulgence in sexual relationships with other people's wives! Please clear this doubt of mine?' Shree Sukhdevji replied 'Super men have been found to transgress the moral code and indulge in aggressive actions but just like fire, which can consume anything, and yet can remain pure and unaffected, these powerful one's cannot be contaminated by any evil. But insignificant man should not imitate them in this respect even mentally. If he behaves like this stupidly, it would be like one who is without the power of Rudra but drinks poison. Death is sure to befall hi. The intelligent man should follow only such actions that are consistent with their teachings.' (Sk 10, Ch 33, 27-32)

Thus one should always stick to what has been said by *Shastras* rather than what has been done in *Shastras*. In our great *Sanatan Dharma* there are three great *Avatars*, viz. Rama, Krishna, and Swaminaryan. Following the examples set by Rama can attain *Mukti*. Following what Krishna in the *Bhagwat Gita* and other *Shastra* has said can also attain it. Finally it can be attained by following the examples set by Purnapurushtottm Bhgawan Swaminarayan and also by obeying his commandment in *Shikshapatri* and other *Shastra*. If we follow this, we are sure to attain God's *Dhaam*.

SHREE SHALINGRAM

- Sadhu Purushottamprakashdas (Jetalpurdham)



Since Aadikal, Narayan Bhagwan is believed to be present in Ram in Vedic and Pauranik pooja-rituals and therefore it was not essential to have Pran-Prathisha. Avahan-Visarjan etc. rituals. With Shalingram, Nitya Sanyog (constant company) of Bhagwati Tulsidevi is believed. During the ancient time, the demon king Jalandhar had his wife Vrinda. She was devout worshipper her husband and due to this, her husband Jalandhar used to break pati-vrata of other married women. Once Jalandhar thought to break patri-vrata of goddess Parvati wife of Lord Shiva. Resultantly, there was great war between Lord Shiva and Jalandhar. However, the king Jalandhar remained invincible. Then all the deities came to Lord Vishnu and ardently requested to control the demon king Jalandhar. Lord Vishnu

took form of king Jalandhar and broke *patri-vrata* of Vrinda, wife of Jalandhar. Vrinda cursed Vishnu to be a stone and in return Lord Vishnu cursed Vrinda to be a plant. Since then, plant of Tulsi and stone called Shaligram are worshipped together popularly known as *Tulsi-Vivah*.

In Vedas, there are certain significant rules about ritual of *pooja* of Shalingram. The form of Shalingram is found in the pious river Gandaki. The flow of the river from Damodar Kund till Muktinath is replete with such stones.

The number of *pooja* of Shalingram should be kept in odd number viz. 1,3,5,7,9 etc. When form of Shalingram is present, we always find *Bhakti* and *Mukti* and deities reside there. When *Vrat-Jap-Tap-Anusthan-pooja*, *Daan*, *pratishta*, *Yagna* etc. are performed in the pious company of Shalingram, it grants special fruits (result).

By placing form of Shalingram in one pious *Paatra*, *Path* of *Purush-Sukta* should be performed and *Abhishek* of *Panchamrit* and clean water should be performed. Thereafter cleaning with neat and clean cloth, *shodasopchar poojan* should be performed. Shalingram should never be kept *Apuj* (without any *poojan*). At night leaves of *Tulsi* should be kept beside Shalingram. Lord Vishnu has blessed Vrinda with the blessings that, without leaves of *Tulsi*, *Naivedya* would not be accepted by Shalingram. Water of *Abhishek* of Shalingram is very pious and capable destroying all sins.

ABHAV-AVAGUN


- Sadhu Ghanshyamprakashdas (Mansa)

After a long journey a traveler was very much tired. He came to a mango tree to take rest. He got sleep under serene breeze of the Summer noon. After some time when he woke up, he found two ripe mangoes lying on the land. He was very hungry and so he ate the mangoes and satisfied his hunger.

This traveler is symbolic. Every soul-Mumukshu – is like this traveler. He is tired of moving in the cycle of birth-death and rebirth. Now he has got a mango tree in the form of Satsang. He is being relaxed with Bhajan-Kirtan and sweet words of the saints. Like ripe mangoes, there is Other Form of Bhagwan, which is capable of satisfying his hunger of so many ages and births.

So devotees! after such a long journey we have got such a sweet Satsang in this life and therefore, we should avail the maximum benefit out of it. Yes it is true that, sometimes our faith, trust and ardent Bhakti may be tested by Almighty Bhagwan but we have to be ready ourselves for such test. Bhagwan may test us from various angles. Sometimes we may feel as if there is nothing like God. Now this is also a kind of test of Bhagwan. How much strong and firm we are in our worship is always going to be tested time and again.

A true Satsangi sees noble qualities in others, and demerits in himself and thereby he strives to improve upon himself. Sometimes the words of Bhagwan and the saints may appear to be very hard or harsh but it is always for our good. However, we



need to cherish unshakable faith in Him and should always be ready to render our devout services.

There may be some devotees, who see demerits and mistakes in other devotees, such type of devotees also cherish self-created thoughts that, these devotees are mistaken and they do not possess correct understanding as to what is the purpose behind such preaching etc. gradually his faith is shaken even from Satsang and Sampradaya and cherishes that, he knows much more than the devotees. Now he becomes uneasy from within just like half-burnt wood. Then he goes in search of self-respect from outside. Gradually he does not like to worship God and resultantly quits his ardent worship.

Such a person is like a dog who carries a bone, eats it alone, bleeds his mouth in doing so and then sucks the blood of his mouth from the bone and enjoys it. Such a devotee can never get emancipation in his life.

A person who develops T.B. at a younger age, does not survive upto his maturity. Similarly, a devotee who develops such wrong type of feelings towards God and devotees, never gets emancipation in his life. To doubt the devotees and the saints is considered to be the greatest of all sins on this earth. Such a person, who has started doubting the saints as well as the devotees, also starts doubting the great scriptures also. Thereby

he accumulates more and more sins and then there remains no scope for his emancipation.

The essence of whole Satsang is given in this small narrative. The message which we need to learn from this is that, we should never think wrong about devotees, saints and Sampradaya. We should cherish ardent faith in our saints and scriptures and Sampradaya because that is the true and correct essence of Sampradaya and the only way to get emancipation in life.

Dharmdev, father of our Bhagwan Shree Sahjanand Swami, used to perform Shodasopchar poojan of Shalingram everyday. After Dharmdev, Shree Ghanshyam Maharaj used to perform poojan everyday. Shalingram was also kept together even during Van-vicharan. While crossing the river Sarayu, everything was swayed away except a book and pooja-peti.

During Van-vicharan in South India in Bhutpuri forest, water was taken out from the well and was offered to Shalingram and thereafter Naivedya was also offered. In Satsang, Shree Hari always performed poojan of Shalingram. Thereafter, two Gadis were established at Ahmedabad and Vadtal and Dharmkul was established as Acharyas of Sampradaya both Desh. Considering the economical condition of Sampradaya of Northern India i.e. Narnarayandev Desh, Shree Ghanshyam Maharaj offered Shalingram to our Aadi Acharya Maharaj H.H. Shri

Ayodhyaprasadji Maharaj of Narnarayandev Desh. Since then all successors of this Narnarayandev Desh Gadi, perform *poojan* of Shalingram. Only Shalingram and Pagh (turban) are offered to the next successor while handing over the reins of Sampradaya. While performing Vicharan for Sampradaya in foreign countries, H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj always keeps Shalingram with him and performs poojan regularly. I myself have witnessed many miracles of Form of Shalingram. The pious water of Snan of Shalingram cures every incurable disease. This is so because Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan Himself has performed poojan of this Form of Shalingram continuously for 38 years.

Many Rishis have prohibited *poojan* of Shalingram by the ladies devotees whereas others have stated that, by performing *poojan* of *Tulsi*, the ladies devotees get *Punya* of *poojan* of both. In our *Vrat-Utsav*, we celebrate *Tulsi-Vivah* from *Kartik Sud Ekadahi* till *Kartik Poonam* every year.

Preaching of Lord Shree Krishna to his friend Uddhav in 11th *Skanda* of *Shriamd Bhagwat Mahapuran* is popularly known as *'Uddhav Gita'*. Here are some excerpts from this great scripture:

"Dear Uddhay! There is nothing like Captivity and Freedom in this world because every Guna is work of Maya and it is Its Form and so there is neither Moksha (emancipation) nor any kind of Bandhan (captivity), Moh, Sukh, Dukh etc. everything is due to Maya. BEG PARDON, BECOME HAPPY - Shastri Haripriyadas (Gandhinagar)

Beautiful rainy season is going on. In all the seasons, rainy season is considered to be Sattvik season and therefore, special *Niyams* are taken during this rainy season. Let us understand about the benefit of such *Niyams* through one story.

Dharampur is a village situated in the lap of nature surrounded by the mountains and three-four water streams and away from big cities. People of this village were very innocent, religious and truth loving. One Kushalchand Sheth was residing in this village Dharampur. He had his own firm and three-four shops. Due to his credit and good reputations, all the villagers used to purchase all essential things from his shops. On increase of the business, Kushalchand Sheth kept one Munim to look after his business. When Kushalchand Sheth was out of Dharampur, Munim used to take care of his business. Observing the faithfulness of Muni, Kushalchand Sheth also entrusted with him all monetary matters.

There was a temple beside bungalow of Sheth. Once villagers decided to perform Bhajan-kirtan regularly from 4.00 to 6.00 hours in the evening. Munim Vakhatchand got interested in Bhajan-Kirtan. Almighty Bhagwan is very merciful and therefore we have got this divine Satsang. While performing Satsang, we forget this worldly life. People of this world strive a lot, yet they never forget this worldly life. It is not necessary to go to the forest and cherish loneliness for this purpose. Even while remaining in this Sansar (social life) we can do so. For that commitment is necessary. Maharaj has asked us to perform Pooja. Even the method of Pooja is also prescribed and described. But it is not stated for how much time pooja should be performed. Why? Because, you can perform pooja as long as you can concentrate your mind in pooja. And therefore duration of pooja of each person depends upon his level of concentration which he develops through constant practice and sincere efforts. Our mind is the cause of happiness and unhappiness of our life. For example, if a cat enters our house and takes away a mouse in her mouth, then we are not unhappy. But if there is a parrot in our house then we feel worried and unhappy, the moment the cat enters our house. This is so because we love the parrot and we do not wish that the bird should be harmed. However, we know that, the cat harm or even kill the parrot and therefore our concern which is the cause of our unhappiness. Otherwise how can a cat make a man unhappy? So it is necessary to develop and train our mind and not to allow towards any worldly affections.

Our Mana is like water. Water creates dirt and water also cleans the dirt. The downward flow of water does not require any efforts from our side; however, upward flow requires special efforts.
